What Is Dual-Credit?

Dual-Credit The initiative promotes the offering of dual credit courses for high school students. A dual credit course is a college course taken by a high school student that earns both college and high school credit at the same time. Courses may be taught using online technology at the high school during high school hours or may be scheduled after school hours.
