## Lakeland College Winter Semester CIC Indigenous Bursary

Applications must be received in the Financial Aid & Awards Office by December 15 for winter term only (5 awards valued at \$2,500 per semester).


The Crown Investments Corporation of Saskatchewan (CIC) has a partnership funding agreement with Lakeland College in support of the CIC Indigenous Bursary. The intent is to provide financial aid to Indigenous students who have demonstrated involvement in leadership, management and community service activities. The Bursary reflects the commitment of CIC, the Crown corporations and the Government of Saskatchewan to support the education sector in building an inclusive workforce across government and to promote economic growth in the Province of Saskatchewan.

#### To be eligible for this Entrance bursary, applicants must:

- · Be of self-declared Indigenous ancestry (includes Status First Nation, Non-Status First Nation, Métis or Inuit).
- Be admitted and enrolled full-time in the first year of a Lakeland College designated program, 20 weeks or more in length, offered on-campus, through distance, delivery, or a combination of on-campus and distance delivery.
- Have been a resident of Saskatchewan during the past 12 months.
- Have completed their last high school grade with a minimum 70% average.
- Based on financial need (60% weighting), and community and/or campus involvement (40% weighting).

#### To be eligible for this Continuing bursary, applicants must:





- Have been a resident of Saskatchewan during the past 12 months.
- Have completed their first year of a two-year Lakeland College program with a minimum 70% average for all classes (GPA of 2.7).
- Based on financial need (75% weighting), and community and/or campus involvement (25% weighting).

#### Additional conditions:

Only students in the designated Business, Trades and Technology and Environmental Science programs are eligible. A complete listing of those programs is available on the Lakeland College website at: lakelandcollege.ca/awards-forms.

This award is not currently available with respect to Lakeland College programs brokered to other institutions.

The bursaries will be paid out in two instalments in the form of a cheque, one upon confirmation of full-time enrolment in semester one and the second upon confirmation of full-time enrolment in semester two. Recipients must continue to be enrolled full-time and have met the Lakeland College requirements for attendance and academic performance to be eligible to receive the second instalment of their bursary.

#### **CIC Bursary Application INSTRUCTIONS**

- Complete all sections. Only complete applications will be considered. A new competition is held each year. Previous recipients should ensure Section 3 is filled out completely, as information from previous applications is not reviewed.
- Enclose a transcript of grades from any post-secondary institution attended (other than Lakeland College) or from high school if you have not completed any post-secondary classes.
- Completed applications must be submitted to the Financial Aid & Awards Office, Lakeland College, Vermilion Campus, 5707 College Drive, Vermilion, AB T9X 1K5 or financialaid@lakelandcollege.ca by midnight December 15 in order to be considered.
