The Métis Education Foundation, an affiliate of the Métis Nation of Alberta, and Lakeland College have established the Métis Scholar Award to encourage academic achievement and to provide financial assistance to Métis students enrolled at Lakeland College.

CONDITIONS

Available to Métis students enrolled full-time in any certificate, diploma, or university transfer program, in any year of study. Recipients must meet the following criteria:

- Have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0, with preference given to applicants that demonstrate both academic achievement and financial need.
- Is not a current client of, or receiving funding from the Rupertsland Institute.
- Must show proof of Métis ancestry by submitting one of the following documents:
 - A current Métis Nation of Alberta membership card; or,
 - A current membership card from Métis Nation British Columbia, Métis Nation Saskatchewan, Manitoba Métis Federation or Métis Nation Ontario; or,
 - A current Métis Nation of Alberta membership card from a parent(supported by the applicants long form birth certificate) or a card from a grandparent (supported by applicant's and parent's long form birth certificate); or,
 - A copy of a verifiable genealogical profile showing Métis Nation ancestry and linkage to the Métis Nation homeland (verified by the Métis Nation of Alberta).
- Must declare that their name will not appear on the Government of Canada's Indian Registry and/or band list pursuant to the Indian Act, and is not Inuk, or a non-status Indian.
- Must have Alberta residency and provide proof of 90 days of consistent residence.
- Must demonstrate Métis Community involvement.
- Submit a letter explaining why they have chosen their field of study, how the award will impact their educational journey, career objectives and outline their involvement in the Métis Community.
